Benefits: Enhanced Gateway would introduce all three colleges distance ed *and services* to students *and faculty* all at once; It can identify services common across the colleges to display on Gateway With the Gateway, there is better connection to colleges' own DE info/sites

Group agreed that a District level DE Gateway can play a role in the above.

2. Gateway Enhancement

Group discussed adding FAQs, "are you web ready", definitions for online courses, and commented that currently most resources are available, but "scattered".
