

# What is an MCI, and what is Triage?

#### **Mass Causality Incident (MCI)**

Any number of casualties that exceed the resources normally available from local resources.

#### Triage

The assignment of Level of Urgency to injury(s) to decide the order of treatment of a large number of patients or casualties.

# Triage Categories

Immediate (I): Survivor has life-threating injuries (airway, bleeding, or shock)

Delayed (D): Injuries do not jeopardize survivor's life; treatment can be delayed

Minor (M): Walking wounded and generally ambulatory

Deceased (DEAD): No respiration after two attempts to open airway






# Immediate or Delayed?

- RPM:
  - Respirations
  - Perfusion
  - Mental Status and/or able to follow commands
    - Person, Place, Time, and Event?
- If they PASS this test = Delayed
- If they **FAIL** this test = **Immediate**

#### **AEIOU – TIPS**

- Alcohol
- Epilepsy
- Insulin (Diabetic)
- Overdose
- Underdose
- Trauma
- Infection
- Poisoning, Psychosis
- Stroke or Shock

#### **DCAP - BTLS**

- Deformities
- Contusions (bruising)
- Abrasions
- Punctures
- Burns
- Tenderness
- Lacerations
- Swelling

- Total of 7 victims
- Based on information given about each victim, assign the appropriate Triage Category for each

- Ambulatory Responds to voice triage
- Minor bleeding
- Normal Blanch



- Bleeding extremity
- Unconscious
- After two attempts to open airway, still not breathing



• Standing, but does not respond to voice commands



- No signs of bleeding
- Unconscious
- Blanch takes 5 seconds



- Non-Ambulatory
- Minor Bleeding
- Normal Blanch
- Normal Breathing
- Follows Commands



- No Bleeding
- Conscious
- Doesn't squeeze hand when asked



- Minor Bleeding
- Conscious but Disoriented
- Breathing rate is 40 per minute
