San Mateo County Community College District would like to invite all interested licensed general and specialty contractors to participate in our pregualification program.

You must possess a valid California Contractor's License and current DIR Registration Number to prequalify. Pursuant to SB 854, no contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid or awarded a contract for a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) per California Labor Code section 1725.5.

We now have two applications:

1) CUPCCAA (Qualified Contractors List) - Informal Bid Qualification

The San Mateo County Community College District has adopted the California Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act (CUPCCAA) under Public Contract Code §22000 et seq. In accordance with the State of California Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Commission, the District is inviting all interested licensed contractors to submit their company for inclusion on the District's list of qualified contractors for calendar year 2020. Per California Public Contract Code 22032, any public works project that is estimated to be below \$200,000.00 is subject to the Informal Bidding Procedures set forth by the CUPCCAA Commission. All trade categories are subject to Informal Bidding Procedures. Contractors that are interested in being on the 2021 Qualified Contractor's List are required to have a current license and are subject to verification from the Contractor State License Board (CSLB).

2) Public Works Projects over \$200,000 (Prequalified Contractors List) - Formal Bid Prequalification

Contractors who wish to be on the District's 2021 Prequalified Contractors List must submit and complete the formal bid prequalification application which includes a general questionnaire. This pertains to our formal bid process for projects of more than \$200,000. You will be asked to upload several documents as part of your application. The documents that need to be uploaded are listed in the "Attachments" section located at the bottom of the application. The documents include information about the following:





The following information needs to be included for each project: Agency/Client, Project Title, Project Location; Contact Name, Title and Phone; Project Architect/Engineer; Project AE Contact Name and Phone; Project Description; Cost; Change Orders; Original Date of Completion; Time Extension Granted; Actual Completion Date; Stop Notices.

Additional Ownership Information: Upload one document providing further information about the ownership of your firm. Label the Document "Additional Ownership Information" The document should include 2 sections.

Section 1; If applicable to your firm, provide an explanation about subsidiary relationships including information about other firms, if one firm owns 50 per cent or more of another, or if an owner, partner, or officer of your firm holds a similar position in another firm.

Section 2: If applicable to your firm, please provide an explanation of any change in ownership.

Prevailing Wage: Does your firm pay at least prevailing wages to your employees? Provide an explanation showing how your company meets the prevailing wage requirement. If your company does not meet the requirement, provide an explanation.

Certified Payroll: In accordance with the California Labor Code, a certified copy of all employees' payroll records shall be made available upon request. Have you provided certified payrolls within the last two (2) years? Attachment should include a sample certified payroll with the following information: project name, name of awarding agency, total certified payroll, contact person name and phone number. If your company does not meet the certified payroll requirement, provide an explanation.

Retirement and Health and Welfare Benefits: Do you currently provide health and welfare benefits and retirement/pension benefits for your employees who are covered by prevailing wage law? If not, provide an explanation.

Letter from Bonding Company: Upload a current letter from your Surety Company indicating that your firm is bondable by them.

Apprenticeships Requirements: Include an explanation showing how your company meets the apprenticeship program requirement. If your company does not meet the requirement, provide an explanation.

Surety Claims: If your firm answered "yes" to Surety Claims question, attach a separate page in the "Surety Claims Details" attachment field. Identify the amount of such claim, the name and telephone number of the claimant, the date of the claim, the grounds for the claim, the present status of the claim, the date of resolution of such claim if resolved, the method by which such was resolved if resolved, the nature of the resolution and the amount, if any, at which the claim was resolved.

Litigation Details: If you answered 'Yes' to any of the Supplemental Questions, upload a page(s) providing the requested information about these claims and/or complaints.
