



THE SIR CYRIL TAYLOR MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FOR STUDY IN THE U.S.

About the Scholarship:

The Sir Cyril Taylor Memorial Scholarship is available for underrepresented or disadvantaged students from any of the 56 Commonwealth countries who wish to study at San Mateo Colleges of Silicon Valley in California, U.S.A. (*Cañada College, College of San Mateo, or Skyline College*).

Who is Eligible?

- Students must self-identify as economically, socially, or educationally disadvantaged.
- Student must either be a citizen or permanent resident of Commonwealth countries.
- Students must have been admitted to one of the three colleges in SMCSV (Cañada College, College of San Mateo, or Skyline College).
- Global Online Learning (GOL) students are not eligible for this scholarship. Students must attend our colleges in person.

Scholarship Amounts:

- The total scholarship amount - \$1,000+ per student.
- Additionally, the college application fee (\$50) as well as the homestay application fee (\$300) will be waived for the selected candidates.
