

46.1	<b>COVID-19 recover plan and Safety</b> 7/28/21: Ray discussed COVID 19 Fact Sheet specifically National Data Tracker: 7 day totals (CDC) and 7 day rolling average (California). Per Dr. Yang, discrepancies occur because cases are reported in different frequencies/day of week and Delta Variant cases are also a factor.  Joe Fullerton expressed concern about pandemic direct/indirect trauma to college community and suggested incorporating trauma informed care.
