YOUR PROGRAM INCLUDES

- Accommodation in twin-bedded rooms in centrally-located hotels in Buenos Aires (4 nights), Iguazú (2 nights), Bariloche (3 nights) and Buenos Aires (1 night). Free wireless internet is included. Upgrade to a single-occupancy room for \$750.

- Meals include daily breakfast at the hotels, a welcome dinner, two group lunches and a farewell dinner.

- Internal flights in Argentina in standard-class with airport transfers between Buenos Aires-Iguazú, Iguazú-Bariloche, and Bariloche-Buenos Aires. Flights include standard luggage allowance of one checked bag up to 33lbs and one cabin bag.

- Activities in Buenos Aires include a sightseeing tour of Buenos Aires featuring the Plaza de Mayo, San Telmo, La Boca, and Recoleta, with entrance to Recoleta cemetery; a full-day excursion to enjoy a Fiesta Gaucha, including horse-back riding or a carriage ride, Gaucho music and dancing; a full-day excursion to Tigre-Delta, including stops in San Isidro and El Tigre and a boat ride on the channels of the Delta; an hour-long Tango lesson and a tango show.

- Activities in Iguazú include a Full Moon excursion on the jungle train to Garganta del Diablo to enjoy the waterfalls under moonlight; a full-day excursion to the Argentinian Falls, (a UNESCO Natural World Heritage Site), including entrance to Iguazú National Park (AR) and a public boat tour of the Iguazú River from Puerto Macuco, taking in both the Brazilian and Argentinian Falls and enjoying the mists. In the National Park the group will have a choice of hiking circuits, varying in difficulty. Some light hiking required- a step-free route is available.

- Activities in Bariloche: a half-day tour starting in the city center, including the Cathedral and main shopping streets then along the edges of Lake Nahuel Huapi, taking the chairlift up to the Cerro Campanario viewpoint over the lakes. The tour concludes along the Llao Llao Peninsula, at a viewpoint over Lake Moreno; a half-day excursion to Victoria Island and Arrayanes Forest where the group will join a public boat tour from Puerto Pañuelo, sailing to Quetruhué Isthmus, and the Arrayanes Forest. Following a tour of the forest pathways and a visit to the Casita del Bosque, the boat continues onto Victoria Island, taking a trail to Playa del Toro to see indigenous rock paintings.

An optional Transportation Package is available consisting of round-trip airfare between San Francisco International (SFO) and Buenos Aires (EZE) and round-trip transfers between the airport in Buenos Aires and the accommodation for an additional \$1639* (\$1475 airfare + \$164 estimated taxes, fees & fuel charges.)
