<b>International airfare</b>	Between \$500 and \$1,000
<b>Personal expenses and meals</b> (AIFS recommends \$700 - \$1,000 per month)	Around \$2,100 - \$3,000
<b>California Community College Tuition</b> (Paid directly to the NCSAC community college(s) in which you enroll – SMCCCD, SRJC, ARC, DVC). If you normally receive financial aid, such as CCPG, to cover your tuition, you may receive financial aid to cover your tuition at the other NCSAC community colleges.
