

The AIFS Internship in Paris program fee of \$8,290 includes the following:

Internship Support

- Guaranteed internship placement upon acceptance into program.
- Access to the renowned CliftonStrengthsFinder assessment.
- One-on-one professional development with the AIFS Abroad Program Advisor including resume review and interview practice
- Video conference or phone interview with the internship organization prior to departure
- Support by local AIFS Internship Coordinator for the duration of the program.
- Orientation program in Milan consists of a meeting with AIFS staff on information such as safety and security, cultural activities, workshops on cultural differences, and a local area walking tour.

Accommodation:

- Single bedrooms within a shared apartment with shared kitchen and living space, laundry access, linens, and Wi-Fi. No meals are provided. Located close to public transportation, students may have a 30-60-minute travel time to their work placement. Apartments are shared with up to 6 other AIFS participants and may be co-ed.

Cultural Activities and Excursions. Typical activities, tours and visits and may include:

- Guided tour of Paris including a boat tour on the Seine and visit to the Arc de Triomphe
- Cheese & Wine tasting
- Macaron workshop
- Bastille Day Military Parade
- Music Festivals
- Excursions to Palace of Versailles, House and gardens of Claude Monet

Also Included:

- Access to the wireless-enabled AIFS Paris Center and a team of dedicated AIFS staff for information, advising, and 24-hour emergency contact service
- Medical insurance policy
- Carbon offsetting for all participants' flights to and from their program location by the purchasing of carbon credits in vetted global projects.

Program does not include the following:

- Round-trip airfare and in-country transfers
- Passport and visa fees if applicable
- SMCCCD tuition or administrative fees or textbooks
- Meals other than those listed.
- Personal expenses
- Anything else not specified.

Refund policy and important dates to remember should you need to cancel your participation:

1. All deposits are non-refundable as they fund core services related to the program. Some of these services include, but are not necessarily limited to admissions counseling, program advising, professional document revision, work put in by the placement team, interview preparation, and access to professional and program resources through the online portal.
2. Should a participant choose to withdraw from their program, eligibility for a refund and the amount of the eligible refund will be determined based on the format outlined below.
3. Using the postmark, email or fax date of a participant's withdrawal letter as the official withdrawal date (or next business day if this is a weekend), the following applies:
